

- to other countries
- to learn about the culture and the language
- act as a cultural ambassador









- the opportunity to experience cultures

- Develops leadership and communication skills
- Advances international understanding and world peace









- Meet people from other countries and experience their culture firsthand
- Gain a better understanding of the basic needs we all share and the diversity that makes each culture unique





## YEP – SEP Facts

BRUXELLES

- 8,000 students /year
- 90% of all Rotary districts
- an affordable exchange program
- open to Rotarians and non-Rotarians youth









- Between the ages of 15 and 19
- At the high-school or equivalent academic level
- Above-average academically
- Socially ready to handle living abroad for an extended period





## YEP – SEP Long-term Exchanges



- A long-term exchange lasts for an academic year.
- Students stay with 3 host families and are required to attend school in their host country.

Our mission: to welcome all young people from the district on the first Tuesday of July to our statutory meeting.










